HOUSE SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 595

A bill to amend 2022 PA 81, entitled "Michigan-Indiana state line remonumentation act," by amending sections 5, 7, 11, and 13 (MCL 54.315, 54.317, 54.321, and 54.323); and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 5. (1) The Michigan-Indiana state line commission is 2 established in the department of licensing and regulatory affairs.
- 3 (2) The commission shall consist of 5 surveyors licensed in 4 this state, 1 of whom is a resident of **or does surveying work or** 5 **operates as a surveyor in** each of the following counties:
 - (a) Berrien County.
- 7 (b) Cass County.
- 8 (c) St. Joseph County.



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- 1 (d) Branch County.
- 2 (e) Hillsdale County.
- 3 (3) The governor shall appoint members of the commission, by
- 4 and with the advice and consent of the senate. The governor shall
- 5 consider for appointment individuals previously appointed to the
- 6 Indiana-Michigan boundary line commission pursuant to former 2010
- 7 PA 259.
- 8 (4) The term of a member of the commission is 2 years or until
- 9 a successor is appointed, whichever is later.
- 10 (5) If a vacancy occurs on the commission, the governor,
- 11 subject to subsection (3), shall appoint an individual to fill the
- 12 vacancy for the balance of the term.
- 13 (6) The governor may remove a member of the commission for
- 14 incompetence, dereliction of duty, malfeasance, misfeasance, or
- 15 nonfeasance in office, or any other good cause.
- 16 (7) The first meeting of the commission shall be called by a
- 17 majority of the members of the commission. The first meeting shall
- 18 be held not later than September 15, 2022. At the first meeting,
- 19 the commission shall elect from among its members a chairperson and
- 20 other officers as it considers necessary or appropriate. After the
- 21 first meeting, the commission shall meet at least not less than
- 22 quarterly, or more frequently at the call of the chairperson or if
- 23 requested by 3 or more members.
 - (8) A majority of the members of the commission constitute a
- 25 quorum for transacting business. A vote in favor by a majority of
- 26 the members serving is required for any action of the commission.
- 27 (9) The commission shall conduct its business in compliance
- 28 with the open meetings act, 1976 PA 267, MCL 15.261 to 15.275.
- 29 (10) A writing that is prepared, owned, used, possessed, or

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- 1 retained by the commission in performing an official function is
- 2 subject to the freedom of information act, 1976 PA 442, MCL 15.231
- 3 to 15.246.
- 4 (11) A member of the commission is not entitled to
- 5 compensation for service on the commission but may be reimbursed
- 6 for actual and necessary expenses incurred in serving.
- 7 Sec. 7. (1) Subject to subsection (2), the commission shall do
- 8 all of the following:
- 9 (a) Administer a survey and remonumentation of the Michigan-
- 10 Indiana state line or any part of the line.
- 11 (b) Recover or reestablish monuments at the mileposts and
- 12 intermediate monument control points of the Michigan-Indiana state
- 13 line or any part of the line as established in the 1827 federal
- 14 survey that defined that line or part of the line. The commission
- 15 also shall recover or reestablish monuments at the posts originally
- 16 set at or near the shores of lakes and large rivers of the
- 17 Michigan-Indiana state line or any part of the line as established
- 18 in the 1827 federal survey, or witness corners for set posts. The
- 19 commission shall review the survey upon completion of each
- 20 milepost.
- 21 (c) Compile appropriate records and documents verifying the
- 22 location of the mileposts and submit those records and documents to
- 23 the respective county peer review groups.
- 24 (d) Resolve any differences revealed by the survey between
- 25 record documents and recovered evidence regarding the location of
- 26 mileposts defining the Michigan-Indiana state line or any part of
- 27 the line.
- 28 (e) Provide regular updates to the department's office of land
- 29 survey and remonumentation.

1	(2) The director of the department's office of land survey and
2	remonumentation shall keep the state survey and remonumentation
3	commission created under section 3 of the state survey and
4	remonumentation act, 1990 PA 345, MCL 54.263, apprised of the
5	Michigan-Indiana state line commission's progress in discharging

7 (3) The commission shall not replace lost corner positions if 8 the state of Indiana does not participate in the survey and 9 remonumentation project as authorized by Indiana law.

its duties under subsection (1).

- 10 (4) To accomplish the purposes of this act, the commission or 11 its representative may meet and collaborate with a similar 12 commission established by the state of Indiana or that commission's 13 representative.
 - Sec. 11. (1) The commission shall procure professional surveying services for the purposes of this act through negotiated contracts or grants to the county remonumentation programs in counties adjacent to the Michigan-Indiana state line.
 - (2) A county receiving grant funds under subsection (1) may provide the professional surveying services or procure professional surveying services through negotiated contracts.
 - (3) The commission or a county shall award contracts only to persons incorporated in this state or with a principal place of business in this state.
 - (4) A county that receives grant funds under subsection (1) shall not commingle the funds with grant funds under the state survey and remonumentation act, 1990 PA 345, MCL 54.261 to 54.279.
- Sec. 13. This act is repealed effective January 1, 2026.**2030**.



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
