ENROLLED SENATE BILL No. 1312

AN ACT to amend chapter X of Act No 288 of the Public Acts of 1939 entitled as amended An act to revise and consolidate the statutes relating to certain aspects of the organization and jurisdiction of the probate court of this state the powers and duties of such court and the judges and other officers thereof certain aspects of the statutes of descent and distribution of property and the statutes governing the change of name of adults and children the adoption of adults and children and the jurisdiction of the juvenile division of the probate court to prescribe the powers and duties of the juvenile division of the probate court and the judges and other officers thereof to prescribe the manner and time within which actions and proceedings may be brought in the juvenile division of the probate court to prescribe pleading evidence practice and procedure in actions and proceedings in the juvenile division of the probate court to provide for appeals from the juvenile division of the probate court to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state departments agencies and officers and to provide remedies and penalties for the violation of this act as amended being sections 710 21 to 710 70 of the Michigan Compiled Laws by adding section 22a

The People of the State of Michigan enact

Section 1 Chapter X of Act No 288 of the Public Acts of 1939 as amended being sections 710 21 to 710 70 of the Michigan Compiled Laws is amended by adding section 22a to read as follows

CHAPTER X

Sec 22a A child shall not be placed with a prospective adoptive parent and an adoption order shall not be issued if a person authorized to place the child or the court authorized to issue the order has reliable information that the prospective adoptive parent has been convicted under any of the following

(a) Section 145a or 145c of the Michigan penal code Act No 328 of the Public Acts of 1931 being sections 750 145a and 750 145c of the Michigan Compiled Laws

(b) Sections 520b to 520g of the Michigan penal code Act No 328 of the Public Acts of 1931 being sections 750 520b to 750 520g of the Michigan Compiled Laws if the victim was under the age of 18 at the time the crime was committed

(c) A law of another state substantially similar to 1 of the sections included in subdivision (a) or (b)

This act is ordered to take immediate effect
