CONTENT

The bill would amend the Michigan Election Law to permit a city or township clerk to consolidate election precincts and, with the consent of the school district election coordinator, to use the school election precincts and polling places, when conducting a school election at the same time as a city or township election.

Under the Election Law, if a city or township is holding an election at the same time that a school district located entirely or partly within the city or township is holding an election, the city or township clerk also must conduct the school district election.
