

SUBSTITUTE FOR
SENATE BILL NO. 1137

A bill to amend 1984 PA 192, entitled
"Forbes mechanical contractors act,"
by amending section 3 (MCL 338.973).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 3. (1) There is created within the department a board of
2 mechanical rules ~~which~~ **THAT** consists of the state fire marshal or
3 the state fire marshal's designee, who shall be a permanent member,
4 and 14 residents of the state to be appointed by the governor with
5 the advice and consent of the senate. Appointed members shall be
6 not less than 18 years of age and qualified in their respective
7 fields. ~~Of the members first appointed, 4 members shall have a~~
8 ~~term of 1 year, 3 members shall have a term of 2 years, 3 members~~

1 ~~shall have a term of 3 years, and 4 members shall have a term of 4~~
2 ~~years.~~ Appointed members of the board shall include 1 person from
3 the general public; a member of organized labor representing the
4 mechanical trades; a professional mechanical engineer registered in
5 this state; a representative of an energy-producing public utility
6 of the state; a representative from each of the work
7 classifications set forth in section 6(3); and 2 chief mechanical
8 inspectors of governmental subdivisions, 1 of whom enforces the
9 building officials and code administrators building code, and 1 of
10 whom enforces the international conference of building officials
11 building code. ~~Except for the initial members, a~~ A member of the
12 board **APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR BEFORE JANUARY 1, 2007** shall be
13 appointed for a term of 2 years, except that a vacancy shall be
14 filled for the unexpired portion of the term. **A MEMBER OF THE BOARD**
15 **APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR AFTER DECEMBER 31, 2006 SHALL BE**
16 **APPOINTED FOR A TERM OF 4 YEARS, EXCEPT THAT A VACANCY SHALL BE**
17 **FILLED FOR THE UNEXPIRED PORTION OF THE TERM.** A member of the board
18 may be removed from office by the governor in accordance with
19 section 10 of article V of the state constitution of 1963. A member
20 of the board who has a pecuniary interest in a matter shall
21 disclose that interest before the board takes action in the matter,
22 which disclosure shall be made a matter of record in the board's
23 official proceedings. Each member of the board, except the state
24 fire marshal or the state fire marshal's designee, shall receive
25 ~~per diem compensation and~~ **REIMBURSEMENT FOR** actual expenses
26 incurred by the member in the performance of his or her duties as a
27 member of the board, **SUBJECT TO AVAILABLE APPROPRIATIONS.**

1 ~~Annually, the legislature shall fix the per diem compensation of a~~
 2 ~~member of the board.~~ Travel or other expenses incurred by a member
 3 of a board in the performance of an official function shall be
 4 payable by the department pursuant to the standardized travel
 5 regulations of the department of management and budget, **SUBJECT TO**
 6 **AVAILABLE APPROPRIATIONS.** A member of the board shall not serve
 7 more than 2 consecutive terms.

8 (2) ~~The board shall hold an organizational meeting within 60~~
 9 ~~days after the effective date of this act.~~ At the first meeting of
 10 each year, the board shall elect from its membership a
 11 ~~chairperson,~~ vice-chairperson ~~—~~, and secretary. The ~~chairperson,~~
 12 vice-chairperson ~~—~~, and secretary shall be elected from those
 13 members appointed to the board by the governor, except that the
 14 board members who are chief mechanical inspectors ~~shall not be~~
 15 **ARE NOT** eligible for election as ~~chairperson or~~ vice-chairperson
 16 of the board. **AFTER DECEMBER 31, 2006, THE GOVERNOR SHALL DESIGNATE**
 17 **1 MEMBER OF THE BOARD TO SERVE AS CHAIRPERSON AT THE PLEASURE OF**
 18 **THE GOVERNOR.**

19 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
 20 unless all of the following bills of the 93rd Legislature are
