1. Primary Care Services	Gross	\$0	\$85,800
Provides an additional \$55,400 for Bay Mills Health Center and an additional \$30,400 for rural health services.	GF/GP	\$0	\$85,800
2. Vision Clinic	Gross	\$0	\$25,000
Provides an additional \$25,000 for the Special Needs Vision Clinic.	GF/GP	\$0	\$25,000
3. Adult Home Help Wage Increase	Gross	\$0	(\$264,400)
Reduces the FY 2007-08 Adult Home Help Services line by \$264,400 gross (\$110,800 GF/GP) due to a change in the implementation of the wage increase. The enrolled HB 4344 funds a minimum wage of \$7.50 per hour as of April 1, 2008, whereas this bill adjusts for savings due to a 10¢ per hour wage increase for all Medicaid adult home help workers who are paid at the minimum wage.
