## 2 PROVISIONS CONCERNING APPROPRIATIONS

## 3 GENERAL SECTIONS

- 4 Sec. 201. In accordance with the provisions of section 30 of
- 5 article IX of the state constitution of 1963, total state spending
- 6 from state resources in this appropriation act for the fiscal year
- 7 ending September 30, 2010 is \$219,200.00 and state appropriations
- 8 paid to local units of government are \$0.
- 9 Sec. 202. The appropriations made and expenditures authorized
- 10 under this act and the departments, commissions, boards, offices,
- 11 and programs for which appropriations are made under this act are
- 12 subject to the management and budget act, 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1101
- **13** to 18.1594.
- 14 Sec. 203. The line-item appropriations in part 1 financed by
- 15 federal funds designated as ARRA funding represent federal funds
- 16 associated with the American recovery and reinvestment act of 2009,
- 17 Public Law 111-5. These federal funds are temporary in nature. It
- 18 is the intent of the legislature that when these temporary federal
- 19 funds are fully expended, the program funding levels and any state
- 20 employees supported by these temporary federal funds will not be
- 21 continued.
- Sec. 210. (1) In addition to the funds appropriated in part 1,
- 23 there is appropriated an amount equal to any additional federal
- 24 funding awarded to this state through recalculation of formulas and
- 25 under the redistribution provisions of the American recovery and
- 26 reinvestment act of 2009, Public Law 111-5.
- 27 (2) Within 30 days of receiving such an award, a department

- 1 shall report to the senate and house appropriations subcommittees,
- 2 senate and house fiscal agencies, state budget director, and the
- 3 governor on the amount of funds received and the purposes for which
- 4 they will be spent.
- 5 Sec. 211. The unexpended funds appropriated in part 1 and in
- 6 section 210 and any unencumbered or unallotted funds are carried
- 7 forward into the succeeding fiscal year. The following is in
- 8 compliance with section 451a(1) of the management and budget act,
- 9 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1451a:
- 10 (a) The purposes of the projects to be carried forward are to
- 11 protect and invest in the natural resources, infrastructure, and
- 12 people of the state of Michigan in accordance with the provisions
- 13 of the American recovery and reinvestment act of 2009, Public Law
- **14** 111-5.
- 15 (b) The projects will be accomplished by state employees and
- 16 by contract.
- 17 (c) The total estimated cost of all projects is identified in
- 18 each line-item appropriation.
- 19 (d) The tentative completion date is September 30, 2012.
- Sec. 212. (1) In a form and manner determined by the recipient
- 21 department, local governments and other eligible sub-recipients
- 22 receiving funds through this act shall comply will all requirements
- 23 corresponding to the receipt of funds, including, but not limited
- 24 to, any certifications, assurances, and accountability and
- 25 transparency provisions required in the American recovery and
- 26 reinvestment act of 2009, Public Law 111-5.
- 27 (2) Funds appropriated in part 1 may be transferred to sub-

- 1 recipient state departments or agencies in an interdepartmental
- 2 grant consistent with the requirements of the American recovery and
- 3 reinvestment act of 2009, Public Law 111-5.
