THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 2690. (1) A person shall not knowingly sell, COLLECT ANY

FEE FOR, transfer, distribute, or give away an embryo, fetus, or

neonate for a use which THAT is in violation of sections 2685 to

2689.

(2) A PERSON SHALL NOT KNOWINGLY FINANCIALLY BENEFIT FROM OR RECEIVE ANY TYPE OF COMPENSATION FOR THE DISTRIBUTION OR TRANSFER OF AN EMBRYO, FETUS, OR NEONATE OR ANY PORTION OF AN EMBRYO, FETUS, OR NEONATE INCLUDING ANY ORGANS, TISSUES, OR CELLS THAT WERE OBTAINED AS THE RESULT OF AN ELECTIVE ABORTION. AS USED IN THIS SUBSECTION, "ELECTIVE ABORTION" MEANS THE INTENTIONAL USE OF AN INSTRUMENT, DRUG, OR OTHER SUBSTANCE OR DEVICE TO TERMINATE A
