

HOUSE BILL No. 5641

May 11, 2016, Introduced by Reps. Barrett, Hughes, Guerra, Durhal, Lucido and Bizon and referred to the Committee on Communications and Technology.

A bill to amend 1961 PA 236, entitled
"Revised judiciary act of 1961,"
(MCL 600.101 to 600.9947) by adding section 2950n.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 2950N. (1) IN AN ACTION DESCRIBED IN SECTION 2950(1) OR
2 2950A(1), THE COURT MAY ENTER A SEPARATE ORDER TO ALLOW THE
3 PETITIONER TO MAINTAIN AN EXISTING WIRELESS TELEPHONE NUMBER, OR
4 THE WIRELESS TELEPHONE NUMBER OF A MINOR CHILD OF WHOM THE
5 PETITIONER HAS LEGAL CUSTODY, IF THE PETITIONER IS NOT THE NAMED
6 CUSTOMER, BY ORDERING THE WIRELESS TELEPHONE SERVICE PROVIDER TO
7 TRANSFER THE BILLING RESPONSIBILITY FOR AND RIGHTS TO THE WIRELESS
8 TELEPHONE NUMBER TO THE PETITIONER.

9 (2) AN ORDER ISSUED UNDER SUBSECTION (1) MUST LIST THE NAME
10 AND BILLING TELEPHONE NUMBER OF THE NAMED CUSTOMER, THE NAME AND
11 CONTACT INFORMATION OF THE PETITIONER, AND EACH TELEPHONE NUMBER TO

1 BE TRANSFERRED TO THE PETITIONER. THE COURT SHALL ENSURE THAT THE
2 CONTACT INFORMATION OF THE PETITIONER IS NOT PROVIDED TO THE
3 CUSTOMER.

4 (3) THIS SECTION AND SECTION 2950○ DO NOT AFFECT THE ABILITY
5 OF THE COURT TO DETERMINE THE TEMPORARY USE, POSSESSION, AND
6 CONTROL OF PERSONAL PROPERTY OR TO APPORTION THE ASSETS AND DEBTS
7 OF THE PARTIES AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED BY LAW.

8 (4) BY JULY 1, 2016, THE STATE COURT ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICE
9 SHALL DEVELOP ANY FORMS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THIS SECTION AND
10 SECTION 2950○.

11 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
12 after the date it is enacted into law.

13 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect
14 unless Senate Bill No. ____ or House Bill No. 5642 (request no.
15 05873'16) of the 98th Legislature is enacted into law.
