

SENATE BILL No. 977

May 19, 2016, Introduced by Senators BIEDA and CASPERSON and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend 2006 PA 384, entitled "Driver education provider and instructor act," by amending section 55 (MCL 256.675).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 55. (1) Before a driver education provider ~~shall provide~~
2 **PROVIDES** behind-the-wheel driver education course instruction to an
3 adult or truck driver training student, the provider shall verify
4 that the student has a valid temporary instruction permit issued by
5 the secretary of state under section 306 of the Michigan vehicle
6 code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.306. **A VALID COMMERCIAL LEARNER'S PERMIT**
7 **ISSUED TO A TRUCK DRIVER TRAINING STUDENT BY A STATE OTHER THAN**
8 **THIS STATE SATISFIES THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SUBSECTION.**

9 (2) The secretary of state may prescribe the method and manner
10 that a driver education provider ~~shall use~~ **USES** to verify a
11 student's temporary instruction permit under this section.

1 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
2 after the date it is enacted into law.

3 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect
4 unless Senate Bill No. 978

5 of the 98th Legislature is enacted into law.
