HOUSE BILL No. 4833

July 12, 2017, Introduced by Rep. Reilly and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to amend 1986 PA 303, entitled

"An act to establish a Michigan work-study program for qualified resident students attending eligible graduate and professional graduate schools and employed by qualified employers; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state agencies; and to provide for an appropriation,"

by amending section 4 (MCL 390.1324).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 4. (1) A student is eligible to participate in the 2 program if the student meets the following requirements:
 - (a) Has resided in this state continuously for the 12 months preceding his or her application to the program and is not considered a resident of any other state.
 - (b) Is a United States citizen or permanent resident of this country.
 - (B) IS A UNITED STATES CITIZEN OR ANY OTHER STUDENT DESCRIBED
 AS ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE TITLE IV, HEA PROGRAM ASSISTANCE UNDER 34

- 2 (c) Is not incarcerated in a corrections institute.
- 3 (d) Is enrolled in at least a half-time graduate program of
- 4 study at a graduate or professional graduate school that meets the
- 5 requirements in section 3.
- **6** (e) Is certified by the financial aid officer at the graduate
- 7 or professional graduate school as needing employment in order to
- 8 meet recognized educational expenses.
- 9 (f) Is not in default on a loan guaranteed by the authority.
- 10 (2) A student shall maintain satisfactory academic progress,
- 11 as defined by the graduate or professional graduate school in which
