## **HOUSE BILL No. 6295**

September 5, 2018, Introduced by Rep. LaFave and referred to the Committee on Local Government.

A bill to prohibit a local unit of government from enacting or enforcing an ordinance or rule that regulates a dog or service animal based on the breed, perceived breed, or a physical characteristic of a breed; and to provide for the powers and duties of certain local governmental entities.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 1. (1) A local unit of government shall not enact or enforce an ordinance or rule that regulates a dog or service animal based on the breed, perceived breed, or a physical characteristic of a breed.
- (2) This act does not prohibit a local unit of government from enacting an ordinance or rule that places restrictions or imposes

- 3 (a) "Dog" means a domestic dog of any age of the species Canis
- 4 familiaris.
- 5 (b) "Local unit of government" means a county, city, village,

- 7 (c) "Service animal" means all of the following:
- 8 (i) That term as defined in 28 CFR 36.104.
- $\mathbf{9}$  (ii) A miniature horse that has been individually trained to
- 10 do work or perform tasks as described in 28 CFR 36.104 for the
- 11 benefit of a person with a disability.
- 12 Enacting section 1. This act takes effect 90 days after the
- 13 date it is enacted into law.
