

SR59, As Adopted by Senate, May 9, 2017

Senator Hertel offered the following resolution:

Senate Resolution No. 59.

A resolution recognizing May 7-13, 2017, as “Women’s Lung Health Week”.

Whereas, Every five minutes, a woman in the U.S. is told she has lung cancer; and

Whereas, Lung cancer is the #1 cancer killer of women in the U.S.; and

Whereas, The lung cancer death rate in women has almost doubled over the past 37 years;
and

Whereas, Advocacy and increased awareness will result in more and better treatment for women with lung cancer and other lung diseases and will ultimately save lives; and

Whereas, Lung Force is the national movement led by the American Lung Association, with the mission of making lung cancer history—uniting women to stand together with a collective strength and determination to lead the fight against lung cancer and for lung health; now, therefore, be it

Resolved by the Senate, That the we hereby recognize May 7-13, 2017, as “Women’s Lung Health Week”; and be further

Resolved, That all Michigan residents be encouraged to learn more about the detection and treatment of lung cancer.
