August 06, 2020, Introduced by Reps. Wittenberg, Hoadley, Brixie, Hood, Ellison, Koleszar, Haadsma, Warren, Sowerby and Rabhi and referred to the Committee on Government Operations.

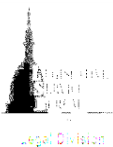
A bill to amend 1911 PA 235, entitled

"An act to provide for the payment and reimbursement by counties, in certain cases upon application therefor, of expenses incurred in the burial of the bodies of honorably discharged members of the armed forces of the United States, or their spouses, and to repeal certain acts or parts of acts,"

by amending sections 2 and 3 (MCL 35.802 and 35.803).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 2. ~~It shall be the duty of the members of the~~**The**
2 soldiers' relief commission of each county, whenever application is



1 made for reimbursement by the county for ~~such~~**the** funeral expenses
 2 paid or advanced, or incurred for the burial of ~~such~~**a** deceased
 3 person, ~~to~~**as described in section 1, shall** make an investigation
 4 of ~~such~~**the** claim and report ~~their~~**its** action to the clerk of the
 5 board of ~~supervisors~~**commissioners** of the county, or to the clerk
 6 of the board of county auditors, as the case may be, in all cases
 7 setting forth all the facts, together with the name, rank, and
 8 command to which ~~such~~**the** soldier, sailor, marine, nurse, or member
 9 of the women's auxiliary belonged, and in case of ~~such~~**wife or**
 10 ~~widow,~~**the spouse or surviving spouse**, the rank and command to
 11 which **his or** her ~~husband~~**spouse** or deceased ~~husband~~**spouse**
 12 belonged, the name and service rendered as ~~such~~**an** army nurse, **if**
 13 **applicable**, the date of his or her death, place where buried, and
 14 his or her residence and occupation while living. ~~They~~**The**
 15 **commission** shall require ~~such~~**the** person or persons ~~who~~**that** paid,
 16 advanced, or incurred ~~such~~**the** burial expenses for ~~such~~**the**
 17 deceased person to furnish the board of ~~supervisors,~~**commissioners,**
 18 or board of county auditors in counties having a board of county
 19 auditors, with a sworn itemized statement of the ~~expense~~**expenses**
 20 incurred in the burial of the deceased ~~person~~**individual** mentioned
 21 in the application. The members of the commission, except where
 22 they are paid a salary, shall receive from the county the sum of
 23 \$2.00 per day for the time actually and necessarily employed by
 24 them in the performance of their duties.

25 Sec. 3. ~~It shall be the duty of the~~**The** clerk of the board of
 26 ~~supervisors~~**commissioners** or board of county auditors, as the case
 27 may be, upon receiving the report and statement of expenses
 28 provided for in ~~the preceding section,~~**to section 2, shall**
 29 transcribe in a book kept for that purpose all the facts contained



1 in ~~said the~~ report ~~respecting such~~ **concerning the** deceased soldier,
 2 sailor, or marine, or the deceased ~~wife or widow~~ **spouse or**
 3 **surviving spouse** of the same, ~~deceased soldier, sailor, or marine,~~
 4 or ~~such~~ deceased army nurse, and ~~to report such the~~ application and
 5 statement to the board of ~~supervisors~~ **commissioners** or the board of
 6 county auditors, as the case may be, at the **respective board's** next
 7 meeting. ~~thereof. It shall be the further duty of said The~~ clerk,
 8 upon the death and burial of any ~~such~~ soldier, sailor, or ~~marine,~~
 9 **marine described in this act** and upon a request ~~therefor, to made~~
 10 **on behalf of that soldier, sailor, or marine, shall** make
 11 application to the proper authorities under the government of the
 12 United States for a suitable headstone ~~as that~~ is now or may

 18 **surviving spouse** of ~~such the~~ soldier, sailor, or marine, or army
 19 nurse, if the ~~same shall~~ **headstone is** now or ~~hereafter~~ **may in the**
 20 **future** be provided by act of ~~congress.~~ **Congress.**

21 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
 22 unless Senate Joint Resolution ____ or House Joint Resolution T
 23 (request no. 02690'19) of the 100th Legislature becomes a part of
 24 the state constitution of 1963 as provided in section 1 of article
 25 XII of the state constitution of 1963.
