by amending section 5 (MCL 247.325).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 5. The state transportation department of state highways
- 2 shall make rules necessary for the administration of this act in

- 5 Laws of 1948. The boards as provided in the administrative
- 6 procedures act of 1969, 1969 PA 306, MCL 24.201 to 24.328. A board
- 7 of county road commissioners may adopt by reference the rules, in
- 8 whole or in part, of the state transportation department of state
- 9 highways or may adopt its own rules after a public hearing of which
- 10 notice has been given as provided in this section. Before January
