October 03, 2019, Introduced by Senators POLEHANKI, MCMORROW, BULLOCK, GEISS, WOJNO, ALEXANDER, BAYER, HERTEL, ANANICH, CHANG and HOLLIER and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

5 **GENERAL SECTIONS**

6 Sec. 201. Pursuant to section 30 of article IX of the state
7 constitution of 1963, total state spending from state sources under
8 part 1 for fiscal year 2019-2020 is \$450,000.00 and total state
9 spending from state sources to be paid to local units of government
10 for fiscal year 2019-2020 is \$450,000.00.

11 Sec. 202. The appropriations made and expenditures authorized
12 under this act and the departments, commissions, boards, offices,
13 and programs for which appropriations are made under this act are
14 subject to the management and budget act, 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1101
15 to 18.1594.

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17 **DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION**

18 Sec. 301. (1) From the funds appropriated in part 1 for school
19 board training grants, the department of education shall approve
20 and fund a training program for board members newly elected or
21 appointed after November 1, 2020 to be completed within the board
22 member's first 2 years of being appointed or elected. The training
23 program described in this section must include, but not be limited
24 to, instruction for board members in all of the following topic
25 areas:

- 26 (a) Conflicts of interest related to board members.
27 (b) Labor relations.
28 (c) Education law.
29 (d) School finance.

1 (e) Board governance.

2 (2) If a board member does not complete a training program
3 described and required under subsection (1), the other board
4 members shall ensure that both of the following are displayed on
5 the school district's, intermediate school district's, or public
6 school academy's website homepage:

7 (a) The noncompliant board member's first and last name.

8 (b) A statement indicating that the board member under
9 subdivision (a) did not complete the training as required under
10 subsection (1).

11 (3) The board shall ensure that the first and last name of
12 each board member who completes a training program described and
13 required under subsection (1) is displayed on the school
14 district's, intermediate school district's, or public school
15 academy's website homepage along with a statement indicating that
16 the board member completed the training.

17 (4) As used in this section, "board member" means a member of
18 the board of a school district or intermediate school district or a
19 member of the board of directors of a public school academy.
