- 2 Work Day.
- 3 Whereas, For more than 150 years, the bicycle has been an
- 4 important and integral part of the lives of most Detroiters; and
- 5 Whereas, A rapidly increasing number of Detroiters consider
- 6 bicycling an environmentally sound, low cost form of transportation
- 7 as well as an excellent opportunity to improve fitness and social
- 8 activity; and
- 9 Whereas, The city of Detroit continues to maintain and develop

- 1 facilities that strengthen its bicycle-friendliness and promote
- 2 bicycling and walking as a means of transportation and recreation;
- 3 and
- 4 Whereas, The Michigan Senate has already recognized the value
- 5 of active modes of transportation and recreation with its
- 6 endorsement of the Joe Louis Greenway; and
- 7 Whereas, The city of Detroit and its surrounding communities
- 8 continue to partner with foundations like the Ralph C. Wilson, Jr.
- 9 Foundation to build more trails and greenways in order to provide
- 10 both transportation and recreation alternatives for users; and
- 11 Whereas, There are many new opportunities to connect and build
- 12 stronger communities through a network of trails and greenways as
- 13 well as nonmotorized transportation corridors; and
- 14 Whereas, Bicycles are playing a large role in helping
- 15 Detroiters get to jobs and school either as a sole means for
- 16 transportation or in combination with public transit; and
- 17 Whereas, The Detroit Greenways Coalition is the host of
- 18 Detroit Bike to Work Day 2019, and although this event is just one
- 19 day, bicycling to work and other destinations may be a practical
- 20 transportation option throughout the year; now, therefore, be it
- 21 Resolved by the Senate, That members of this legislative body
- 22 recognize May 17, 2019, as Detroit Bike to Work Day; and be it
- 23 further
- 24 Resolved, That we commend the efforts of the Detroit Greenways
- 25 Coalition as well as multiple corporate and private sector partners
- 26 to build a stronger Detroit, encourage nonmotorized transportation,
- 27 link the communities of Southeast Michigan, and wholeheartedly
- 28 encourage participation on Detroit Bike to Work Day 2019.
