CAPITAL OUTLAY

Sec. 203. Michigan Technological University – H-STEM Engineering and Health Technology Complex, Phase 1 Project Cost Increase

Provides for a \$8.4 million cost increase for the Michigan Technological University – H-STEM Engineering and Health Technology Complex, Phase 1 project that was approved for construction authorization in 2020 PA 257 at a total project cost of \$44.7 million; a state share of \$29.7 million; and a university share of \$15.0 million. The university would be responsible for funding the entire cost increase resulting in a university share of \$23.4 million and a total project cost of \$53.1 million. The cost increase is the result of increased building and construction material costs.
