SUMMARY:

House Bill 5938 would repeal section 30 of the Michigan Campaign Finance Act, which prohibits retaining campaign contributions made in violation of a provision of the Michigan Gaming Control and Revenue Act that was itself repealed in 2019.

MCL 169.230 (repealed)

FISCAL IMPACT:

The bill would have no fiscal impact on the state or local units of government.
