SUMMARY:

House Bill 5078 would amend the Michigan Memorial Highway Act to designate highway M-22 in Leelanau County, from North Stallman Road to North Putman Road, as the "Company K Indian Veterans 1st Michigan Sharpshooters Civil War Memorial Highway."

Proposed MCL 250.1108

BACKGROUND:

The bill is identical to Senate Bill 41 of the current legislative session, which was reported from the House Transportation and Infrastructure committee.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Section 2 of the Michigan Memorial Highway Act provides that the state transportation department shall provide for the erection of suitable markers indicating the name of the highway only "when sufficient private contributions are received to completely cover the cost of erecting and maintaining those markers." As a result, the bill has no state or local fiscal impact.
