SUMMARY:

House Bill 5127 would amend 1973 PA 116, the child care licensing act, to provide that the act's provisions governing child care centers located in buildings with multiple occupants do not authorize the Department of Lifelong Education, Advancement, and Potential to regulate a building occupant that is not a child care center or to regulate any parts of the building that are not used as a child care center.
