SUMMARY:

House Bill 5127 would amend 1973 PA 116, the child care licensing act, to provide that the act's provisions governing child care centers located in buildings with multiple occupants¹ do not authorize the Department of Lifelong Education, Advancement, and Potential to regulate a building occupant that is not a child care center or to regulate any parts of the building that are not used as a child care center.
