

HOUSE BILL NO. 5122

October 23, 2025, Introduced by Reps. St. Germaine, Greene, Aragona and BeGole and referred to Committee on Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 1998 PA 58, entitled
"Michigan liquor control code of 1998,"
(MCL 436.1101 to 436.2303) by adding section 202.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 **Sec. 202. A consumer may use a qualified photo identification**
2 **to verify the consumer's age to purchase or consume alcoholic**
3 **liquor under this act. As used in this section:**

4 **(a) "Consumer" means that term as defined in section 203.**

5 **(b) "Qualified photo identification" means any of the**
6 **following:**

1 (i) An operator's or chauffeur's license issued under the
2 Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.1 to 257.923, or an
3 enhanced driver license issued under the enhanced driver license
4 and enhanced official state personal identification card act, 2008
5 PA 23, MCL 28.301 to 28.308.

6 (ii) An official state personal identification card issued
7 under 1972 PA 222, MCL 28.291 to 28.300, or an enhanced official
8 state personal identification card issued under the enhanced driver
9 license and enhanced official state personal identification card
10 act, 2008 PA 23, MCL 28.301 to 28.308.

11 (iii) A current operator's or chauffeur's license issued by
12 another state.

13 (iv) A current state personal identification card issued by
14 another state.

15 (v) A current state government issued photo identification
16 card.

17 (vi) A current United States passport or federal government
18 issued photo identification card.

19 (vii) A current military photo identification card.

20 (viii) A current tribal photo identification card.

21 (ix) A current photo identification card issued by a local
22 government.

23 (x) A current student photo identification card issued by an
24 educational institution.
