THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 202. A consumer may use a qualified photo identification
- 2 to verify the consumer's age to purchase or consume alcoholic

- 11 (iii) A current operator's or chauffeur's license issued by
- 12 another state.
- 13 (iv) A current state personal identification card issued by
