A bill to amend 2006 PA 480, entitled "Uniform video services local franchise act," by amending section 1 (MCL 484.3301).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. (1) This act shall be known and may be cited as the
- 2 "uniform video services local franchise act".
- 3 (2) As used in this act:
- 4 (a) "Cable operator" means that term as defined in 47 USC
- **5** 522 (5).
- **6** (b) "Cable service" means that term as defined in 47 USC

- **1** 522(6).
- 2 (c) "Cable system" means that term as defined in 47 USC
- **3** 522(7).

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- 4 (d) "Commission" means the Michigan public service commission
- 5 created in section 1 of 1939 PA 3, MCL 460.1.
- 6 (e) "Franchising entity" means the local unit of government in7 which a provider offers video services through a franchise.
- 8 (f) "Household" means a house, an apartment, a mobile home, or
 9 any other structure or part of a structure intended for residential
 10 occupancy as separate living quarters.
 - (g) "Incumbent video provider" means a cable operator serving cable subscribers or a telecommunication provider providing video services through the provider's existing telephone exchange boundaries in a particular franchise area within a local unit of government on the effective date of this act. January 1, 2007.
- 16 (h) "IPTV" means internet protocol television.
- 17 (i) "Local unit of government" means a city, village, or
 18 township.
- 19 (j) "Low-income household" means a household with an average
 20 annual household income of less than \$35,000.00 as determined by
 21 the most recent decennial census.
- (k) "Open video system" or "OVS" means that term as defineddescribed in 47 USC 573.
- (1) "Person" means an individual, corporation, association,partnership, governmental entity, or any other legal entity.
- (m) "Public rights-of-way" means the area on, below, or above
 a public roadway, highway, street, public sidewalk, alley,
 waterway, or utility easements dedicated for compatible uses.
- (n) "Uniform video service local franchise agreement" or

- 1 "franchise agreement" means the franchise agreement required under
- 2 this act to be the operating agreement between each franchising
- 3 entity and video service provider in this state.
- 4 (o) "Video programming" means that term as defined in 47 USC
- **5** 522 (20).
- 6 (p) "Video service" means video programming, cable services,
- 7 IPTV, or OVS provided by a video service provider through
- 8 facilities located at least in part in the public rights-of-way
- 9 without regard to delivery technology, including internet protocol
- 10 technology. This definition Video service does not include any
- 11 video of the following:
- 12 (i) Video programming provided by a provider of a commercial
- 13 mobile service provider as that term is defined in 47 USC 332(d).
- 14 or provided solely as part of, and via,
- 15 (ii) Direct-to-home satellite services as that term is defined
- 16 in 47 USC 303(v).
- 17 (iii) Video programming accessed via a service that enables
- 18 users to access content, information, electronic mail, email, or
- 19 other services offered over the public internet, including
- 20 streaming content.
- 21 (q) "Video service provider" or "provider" means a person
- 22 authorized under this act to provide video service.
- (r) "Video service provider fee" means the amount paid by a
- 24 video service provider or incumbent video provider under section 6.
- 25 (3) The amendatory act that added this subsection does not
- 26 affect the obligation of a provider that holds a uniform video
- 27 local franchise agreement on or before the effective date of the
- 28 amendatory act that added this subsection to provide the
- 29 compensation required under this act for use of a public right-of-

1 way.
