HOUSE BILL NO. 5128

October 23, 2025, Introduced by Reps. Carra, DeSana, Fox, Pavlov and Kelly and referred to Committee on Finance.

A bill to provide for specie legal tender in this state; to create certain rights related to specie legal tender; and to provide for the powers and duties of certain state governmental officers and entities.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 1. This act may be cited as the "specie legal tender
 act".
- 3 Sec. 2. As used in this act:
- 4 (a) "Person" means an individual or a partnership,
- 5 corporation, limited liability company, association, governmental
- 6 entity, or other legal entity.

- 1 (b) "Specie legal tender" means either of the following:
- 2 (i) Gold or silver coin that is issued by the United States.
- 3 (ii) Any other gold or silver coin or bullion if either of the 4 following conditions apply:
- 5 (A) A court of competent jurisdiction issues a final,
- 6 unappealable judgment or order determining that this state may
- 7 recognize the gold or silver coin or bullion as legal tender in
- 8 this state.
- 9 (B) A United States law does either of the following:
- 10 (I) Provides that the gold or silver coin or bullion is legal
- 11 tender in this state.
- 12 (II) Allows this state to recognize the gold or silver coin or
- 13 bullion as legal tender in this state.
- 14 (c) Specie legal tender does not include a central bank
- 15 digital currency.
- Sec. 3. (1) Specie legal tender is legal tender in this state.
- 17 A person may keep and use specie legal tender. Except as expressly
- 18 provided by contract, a person shall not compel another person to
- 19 tender or accept specie legal tender.
- 20 (2) A central bank digital currency is not legal tender in
- 21 this state.
- 22 Sec. 4. A governmental entity shall not do any of the
- 23 following:
- 24 (a) Except as otherwise authorized by law, seize from a person
- 25 specie legal tender that is owned by the person.
- 26 (b) Enforce or attempt to enforce a law that infringes on the
- 27 right of a person to keep and use specie legal tender.
- 28 (c) Restrict the ability of a person to acquire specie legal
- 29 tender or use specie legal tender in a transaction.

- 1 (d) Enact or enforce a law that discriminates or favors 1
- 2 means of legal tender in the course of a transaction over another
- 3 means of legal tender.
