## **HOUSE BILL NO. 5130**

October 23, 2025, Introduced by Reps. Kelly, DeSana, Fox, Pavlov and Carra and referred to Committee on Finance.

A bill to amend 1937 PA 94, entitled "Use tax act,"

by amending section 4u (MCL 205.94u), as added by 1999 PA 225.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 4u. (1) Beginning July 7, 1999, the tax under this act
- 2 does not apply to the storage, use, or consumption of investment
- 3 coins and bullion.
- 4 (2) As used in this section:
- 5 (a) "Bullion" means gold, silver, or platinum in a bulk state,
- 6 where its value depends on its content rather than its form, with a

- 1 purity of not less than 900 parts per 1,000. Beginning January 1,
- 2 2026, bullion includes leaf, foil, or film of gold, silver, or
- 3 platinum that has a metallic content of 50% or more, exclusive of
- 4 any transparent polymer holder, coating, or encasement, and that is
- 5 used as currency, but is not legal tender issued by the United
- 6 States government or a foreign government.
- 7 (b) "Investment coins" means numismatic coins or other forms
- 8 of money and legal tender manufactured of gold, silver, platinum,
- 9 palladium, or other metal and issued by the United States
- 10 government or a foreign government with a fair market value greater
- 11 than the face value of the coins.
- 12 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 13 unless all of the following bills of the 103rd Legislature are
- 14 enacted into law:
- 15 (a) House Bill No. 5131 (request no. H03720'25).
- 16 (b) House Bill No. 5129 (request no. H03721'25).
