## **HOUSE BILL NO. 5156**

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code,"

(MCL 257.1 to 257.923) by adding section 606c.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 606c. (1) A local law enforcement agency may, by means of
- 2 police officers or temporary traffic control devices, temporarily
- 3 guide, direct, control, or stop traffic on a highway or street
- 4 within the geographic jurisdiction of the local law enforcement
- 5 agency if necessary for public safety because of an emergency or

- 1 event, including, but not limited to, either of the following:
- 2 (a) A large-scale march, parade, or protest.
- 3 (b) A terrorist attack or other violent act.
- 4 (2) Subsection (1) applies to any state or local highway or 5 street within the geographic jurisdiction of the local law
- 6 enforcement agency.
- 7 (3) As used in this section, "local law enforcement agency"
- 8 means a county sheriff's office or a police department of a city,
- 9 village, or township.
