A bill to amend 1956 PA 218, entitled "The insurance code of 1956,"

(MCL 500.100 to 500.8302) by adding section 3406rr.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 3406rr. (1) An insurer that delivers, issues for
- 2 delivery, or renews in this state a health insurance policy that
- 3 provides coverage for prescription drugs for advanced metastatic
- 4 cancer and associated conditions shall not require, before coverage
- 5 is provided, that an enrollee do either of the following:
- 6 (a) Fail to successfully respond to a different prescription

- 1 drug.
- 2 (b) Prove a history of failure of a different prescription
- 3 drug.
- 4 (2) As used in this section:
- 5 (a) "Advanced metastatic cancer" means cancer that has spread
- 6 from the primary or original site of the cancer to nearby tissues,
- 7 lymph nodes, or other areas or parts of the body.
- 8 (b) "Associated conditions" means the symptoms or side effects
- 9 associated with advanced metastatic cancer or its treatment, that,
- 10 in the judgment of the health care provider, further jeopardize the
- 11 health of the patient if left untreated.
