A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

(MCL 333.1101 to 333.25211) by adding section 18830.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 18830. (1) A licensee shall not perform by any means any
- 2 of the following on a cat, unless the procedure is necessary to
- 3 address a therapeutic purpose:
- 4 (a) An onychectomy.
- 5 (b) A partial or complete phalangectomy.

- 1 (c) A tendonectomy procedure.
- 2 (d) Any other surgical procedure that prevents normal3 functioning of the claws, toes, or paws of the cat.
- 4 (2) As used in this section:
- 5 (a) "Cat" means a domestic cat of the species *Felis catus* or a
 6 hybrid of that species. Cat includes, but is not limited to, a
 7 savannah cat, Serengeti cat, Maine coon, Bengal cat, or chausie.
- 8 (b) "Therapeutic purpose" means a physical medical condition 9 of a cat, including, but not limited to, an existing or recurring 10 illness, infection, disease, injury, or abnormal condition in the 11 claw of a cat that compromises the cat's health. Therapeutic 12 purpose does not include a cosmetic or aesthetic reason or a reason 13 of convenience in keeping or handling a cat.
