THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 47331. (1) Upon \mathbf{On} the payment of the fee provided for in
- 2 section 47330, the department shall have prepared prepare and shall
- ${f 3}$ issue to a person entitled to the same, a printed or written
- 4 license signed by the department setting forth the date of issuing
- 5 the license, to whom the license was issued, the date on which $\frac{\mathrm{i}t}{\mathrm{i}t}$
- 6 will expire, the license expires, the name or number of the

- 1 license, and the number of and kind of boat, tug, or launch,
- 2 including vessel for which the license was issued, and the number
- 3 of and kind of net or nets for which the license was issued. A
- 4 licensee may list single or multiple vessels on each license, list
- 5 the same vessel or vessels on each license, and may add or subtract
- 6 vessels at any time on a license on written notification to the
- 7 department. The department shall also issue, with the license, a
- 8 suitable tag bearing the license number and the year for which the
- 9 license was issued which that must be attached to the boat a vessel
- 10 to facilitate identification. The department, upon on application
- 11 and the payment of a fee of \$1.00, may do 1 or more of the
- 12 following:
- 13 (a) Permit the transfer of a license to a larger or a smaller
- 14 boat or to any boat, tug, or launch vessel during a period of time
- 15 that the licensed boat, tug, or launch vessel is disabled and
- 16 undergoing repairs.
- 17 (b) In case of the sale If the owner sells or the transfer of
- 18 transfers the title of any licensed boat, vessel, transfer the
- 19 license to the new owner or owners. However, if the sale or
- 20 transfer is to a nonresident as determined by the preceding
- 21 sections, under section 47330, then the difference between the fee
- 22 for a resident license and a nonresident license shall must also be
- **23** paid.
- 24 (c) In case of the loss of a If a vessel by fire, collision,
- 25 or otherwise, for which a license has been issued is lost by fire,
- 26 collision, or otherwise, transfer the license to any similar boat
- 27 vessel to which the licensee may acquire title.
- 28 (2) Whenever If a license is transferred to a larger boat,
- 29 vessel, the difference between the fee paid for the license and the

- 1 fee required by this part for that boat shall vessel must also be
- 2 paid. A refund shall is not be made when if a license is
- 3 transferred to a smaller boat. vessel. However, any boat vessel to
- 4 which a license has been transferred as provided in this section
- 5 shall must be used in the taking, catching, or killing of fish or
- 6 in the setting or pulling of nets, set hook lines, or other
- 7 commercial fishing devices, only within a radius of 50 miles of the
- 8 port designated in the license as originally issued. , and not more
- 9 than 1 license shall be issued for any 1 boat in any 1 calendar
- 10 year. The owner of any licensed boat vessel acquired from the
- 11 estate of a deceased licensee or as a result of bankruptcy
- 12 proceedings may, in addition to having the license transferred in
- 13 his or her the owner's name, have a port of his or her the owner's
- 14 choice designated in the license.
