## **SENATE BILL NO. 644**

October 30, 2025, Introduced by Senators VICTORY and ALBERT and referred to Committee on Government Operations.

A bill to amend 2018 PA 540, entitled "Economic development incentive evaluation act," by amending sections 3, 5, and 7 (MCL 18.1753, 18.1755, and 18.1757).

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 3. As used in this act:
- 2 (a) "Contractor" means the private entity, nonprofit entity,
- 3 or academic institution selected by the department under section 5
- 4 to evaluate certain economic development incentives.

- 1 (b) "Bureau" means the bureau of fair competition and free 2 enterprise created in section 7 of the economic development fair 3 competition and free enterprise act.
- 4 (c) (b) "Department" means the department of technology,
  5 management, and budget.
- (d) (e) "Economic development incentive" means the abatements, tax credits, exemptions, grants, loans, or loan guarantees related to economic development activities in this state, as determined by the Michigan strategic fund bureau, provided under the following

- (e) (d) "Exclusive economic development incentive" means an
- 17 economic development incentive that is intended to encourage a
- 18 single specific entity, project, or associated projects to locate,
- 19 expand, invest, or remain in this state or to hire or retain
- 20 employees in this state as determined by the strategic fund.
- (e) "The strategic fund" means the fund under the Michigan
- 22 strategic fund act, 1984 PA 270, MCL 125.2001 to 125.2094.
- Sec. 5. (1) The department shall contract with 1 or more
- 24 contractors for the periodic evaluation of economic development
- 25 incentives. The department along with the department of treasury
- 26 and the Michigan strategic fund bureau shall develop a scope of
- 27 services for a request for proposals for professional services
- 28 necessary to complete the economic development incentive
- 29 evaluations under this act. The department may solicit input from a

- 1 local governmental unit or 1 or more public agencies, as those
- 2 terms are defined in section 2 of the urban cooperation act of
- 3 1967, 1967 (Ex Sess) PA 7, MCL 124.502, or a Michigan economic
- 4 development corporation corporate partner, in developing the scope
- 5 of services for a request for proposal for professional services
- 6 necessary to complete an economic development incentive evaluation
- 7 under this act. When selecting a contractor, the department shall
- 8 consider the ability for economic development incentive evaluations
- 9 to be done in an objective manner.
- 10 (2) The contractor will must complete the economic development
- 11 incentive evaluations within not later than 270 days of after
- 12 entering into the contract. The department shall provide the
- 13 economic development incentive evaluation with any additional
- 14 information to the house and senate appropriations committees no
- 15 more not later than 30 days after the completion of the evaluation.
- 16 (3) The department shall enter into contracts with contractors
- 17 for economic development incentive evaluations as follows:
- 18 (a) At least once every 6 years for economic development
- 19 incentives funded with state appropriations of \$15,000,000.00 or
- 20 less each year.
- 21 (b) At least once every 4 years for all other economic
- 22 development incentives, excluding programs that have entered into
- 23 legacy status. A program is considered to be in legacy status if
- 24 the Michigan strategic fund board bureau or other governing body
- 25 has not approved, authorized, or originated any new abatement, tax
- 26 credit, or exemption, or distributed funds under a grant, loan, or
- 27 loan guarantee within the immediately preceding fiscal year period.
- 28 (c) Upon On the conclusion of an economic development
- 29 incentive, a 1-time final analysis.

- (4) At the request of the department, state agencies shall 1 2 provide to the contractor, to the extent permitted by law, any records, information, data, or data analysis necessary for the 3 contractors to effectively evaluate the economic development 4 5 incentives. The contractor shall not disclose or release any data 6 received from state agencies, except as permitted by law. A record 7 or portion of a record, material, or other data that relates to 8 financial, commercial, or proprietary information of any entity 9 that received an economic development incentive provided by another 10 department, agency, municipality, or political subdivision of this 11 state to the department or a contractor in connection with review 12 of an economic development incentive under this act shall is not be subject to the disclosure requirements of the freedom of 13 14 information act, 1976 PA 442, MCL 15.231 to 15.246. The department 15 and contractor may only use the financial or commercial information 16 only for carrying out the purposes of this act and shall not 17 disclose or release any data received from a department, agency, 18 municipality, or political subdivision of this state.
- 19 (5) Economic development incentive evaluations shall must be
  20 published on the department's website. The department shall also
  21 publish the name of each contractor who is awarded a contract under
  22 this act and a schedule of economic development incentives and when
  23 they shall will be evaluated.
  - (6) Not less than 30 days prior to before the department releasing releases the economic development incentive evaluation under subsection (2) or publishing publishes it on the department's website under subsection (5), the department shall provide a copy of the economic development incentive evaluation to the Michigan strategic fund, the Michigan economic development corporation,

- 1 bureau, the state agency that has oversight of the economic
- 2 development incentive, and the entity that is the recipient of the
- 3 economic development incentive. The Michigan strategic fund, the
- 4 Michigan economic development corporation, bureau, the state agency
- 5 that has oversight over the economic development incentive, and the
- 6 entity that is the recipient of the economic development incentive
- 7 may issue a response to the economic development incentive
- 8 evaluation.
- 9 Sec. 7. The department, in conjunction with the strategic fund
- 10 bureau and the department of treasury, shall , not later than
- 11 February 28, 2019, develop a multiyear schedule that lists all
- 12 economic development incentives and indicates the year when an
- 13 economic development incentive evaluation will be published for
- 14 each economic development incentive. The department shall consider
- 15 economic development incentive sunset dates and program inactivity
- 16 when creating the schedule and may group economic development
- 17 incentives for review by objective or policy rationale of each
- 18 economic development incentive. The department shall update the
- 19 schedule annually and include any new economic development programs
- 20 as determined by the Michigan strategic fund. bureau. The
- 21 department shall also list all economic development incentives that
- 22 are exclusive economic development incentives.
- 23 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 24 unless Senate Bill No. 631 of the 103rd Legislature is enacted into
- **25** law.
