## **SENATE BILL NO. 673**

October 30, 2025, Introduced by Senator ALBERT and referred to Committee on Government Operations.

A bill to amend 1998 PA 409, entitled "Michigan freedom trail commission act,"

by amending sections 2 and 3 (MCL 399.82 and 399.83), as amended by  $2001 \ PA \ 79$ .

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 2. As used in this act:
- 2 (a) "Department" means the department of history, arts, and
- 3 libraries.natural resources.
- 4 (b) "Michigan freedom trail commission" or "commission" means
- 5 the Michigan freedom trail commission created in section 3.

- 1 (c) "Michigan history center" means the Michigan history
  2 center created in section 3 of the Michigan history center act,
  3 2016 PA 470, MCL 399.803.
- 4 Sec. 3. (1) The Michigan freedom trail commission is created 5 within the department. The budgeting, procurement, and related
- 6 functions of the commission and administrative responsibilities for
- 7 the staff of the commission  $\frac{1}{2}$  must be performed under the
- 8 direction and supervision of the department.
- 9 (2) The commission shall consist consists of the following
  10 members:
- 11 (a) One member appointed by the speaker of the house of
  12 representatives.
- 13 (b) One member appointed by the senate majority leader.
- 14 (c) Nine members appointed by the governor, as follows:
- 15 (i) Three members from the academic community knowledgeable in
  16 African-American history.
- 17 (ii) One member actively involved in civil rights issues.
- 18 (iii) One member knowledgeable in historic preservation.
- 19 (iv) One member representing local communities in which the20 underground railroad had a significant presence.
- (v) Three members at large, 1 of whom shall must be a
   representative of the museum Museum of African American history
   History located in the city of Detroit.
- 24 (d) Three members serving ex officio without vote as follows:
- (i) The chief executive officer of the Michigan economic
   development corporation director of the Michigan history center or
   his or her representative.
- 28 (ii) The state librarian or his or her representative.
- 29 (iii) The director of the department or his or her

- 1 representative.
- (3) The members appointed under subsection (2) (c) first
   appointed to the commission shall must be appointed within 90 days
   after December 21, 1998.not later than March 21, 1999.
- 5 (4) Members of the commission appointed under subsection 6 (2)(c) shall serve for terms of 4 years or until a successor is 7 appointed, whichever is later, except that of the members first 8 appointed 3 shall serve for 1 year, 3 shall serve for 2 years, and 9 3 shall serve for 3 years. A member of the commission appointed by 10 the speaker of the house of representatives or the senate majority 11 leader under subsection (2)(a) or (b), respectively, shall hold 12 office for a term of 2 years to coincide with the term of office of 13 state representative.
- 14 (5) A vacancy on the commission shall must be filled for the
  15 unexpired term in the same manner as the original appointment.
- 16 (6) The governor, speaker of the house of representatives, or 17 senate majority leader may remove a member of the commission 18 appointed by him or her that individual for incompetency, 19 dereliction of duty, malfeasance, misfeasance, or nonfeasance in 20 office, or any other good cause.
  - (7) At the first meeting, the commission shall elect from among its members a chairperson and other officers as it considers necessary or appropriate. After the first meeting, the commission shall meet at least quarterly, or more frequently at the call of the chairperson or if requested by 7 or more members appointed under subsection (2)(a), (b), and (c).
- (8) A majority of the members of the commission appointed
  under subsection (2)(a), (b), and (c) constitute a quorum for the
  transaction of business at a meeting of the commission. A majority

- 1 of the members appointed under subsection (2)(a), (b), and (c)
- 2 present and serving are required for official action of the
- 3 commission.
- 4 (9) The business that the commission may perform shall be
- 5 conducted at a public meeting of the commission held in compliance
- 6 with the open meetings act, 1976 PA 267, MCL 15.261 to 15.275.
- 7 (10) A writing prepared, owned, used, in the possession of, or
- 8 retained by the commission in the performance of an official
- 9 function is subject to the freedom of information act, 1976 PA 442,
- **10** MCL 15.231 to 15.246.
- 11 (11) Members of the commission shall serve without
- 12 compensation. However, members of the commission may be reimbursed
- 13 for their actual and necessary expenses incurred in the performance
- 14 of their official duties as members of the commission.
- 15 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 16 unless Senate Bill No. 631 of the 103rd Legislature is enacted into
- **17** law.
