## **SENATE BILL NO. 711**

November 13, 2025, Introduced by Senators SHINK, CHANG, GEISS and POLEHANKI and referred to Committee on Energy and Environment.

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act," by amending section 3103 (MCL 324.3103), as amended by 2005 PA 33.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 3103. (1) The department shall protect and conserve the
- ${f 2}$  water resources of the this state and shall—have control of the
- 3 pollution of surface or and underground waters of the state and the
- 4 Great Lakes, which are or may be affected by waste disposal of any
- 5 person. The department may make or cause to be made surveys,

- 1 studies, and investigations of the uses of waters of the state,
- 2 both surface and underground, and cooperate with other governments
- 3 and governmental units and agencies in making the surveys, studies,
- 4 and investigations. The department shall assist in an advisory
- 5 capacity a flood control district that may be authorized by the
- 6 legislature. The department, in the public interest, shall appear
- 7 and present evidence, reports, and other testimony during the
- 8 hearings involving the creation and organization of flood control
- 9 districts. The department shall advise and consult with the
- 10 legislature on the obligation of the this state to participate in
- 11 the costs of construction and maintenance as provided for in the
- 12 official plans of a flood control district or intercounty drainage
- 13 district.
- 14 (2) The department shall enforce this part and may promulgate
- 15 rules as it considers necessary to carry out its duties under this
- 16 part. However, notwithstanding any rule-promulgation authority that
- 17 is provided in this part, except for rules authorized under section
- 18 3112(6), the department shall not promulgate any additional rules
- 19 under this part after December 31, 2006.
- 20 (3) The department may promulgate rules and take other actions
- 21 as may be necessary to comply with the federal water pollution
- 22 control act, 33 USC 1251 to <del>1387,</del> **1389**, and to expend funds
- 23 available under such that law for extension or improvement of the
- 24 state or interstate program for prevention and control of water
- 25 pollution. This part shall—is not be—construed as authorizing the
- 26 department to expend or to expend any state
- 27 funds for such that purpose in excess of any amount that is
- 28 appropriated by the legislature.
- 29 (4) Notwithstanding the limitations on rule promulgation under

- 1 subsection (2), rules promulgated under this part before January 1,
- 2 2007 shall remain in effect unless rescinded.
