- 1 A resolution to commemorate the Detroit Red Wings on their
- 2 100th season.
- 3 Whereas, The Detroit Red Wings were founded in 1926 as part of
- 4 what would later be recognized as the "Original Six" era of the
- 5 National Hockey League. The team was first called the Detroit
- 6 Cougars, then the Detroit Falcons, before adopting their iconic
- 7 name, the Detroit Red Wings, in 1932; and
- 8 Whereas, The organization has long embodied the heart and

- 1 spirit of both the city of Detroit and the state of Michigan. Their
- 2 winged wheel logo is a homage to the strength, speed, and
- 3 industrious legacy of Detroit's automotive workforce. For a
- 4 century, the Red Wings have reflected the resilience of Detroiters
- 5 and the grit of Michiganders alike; and
- 6 Whereas, Since their founding, the Detroit Red Wings have
- 7 become the most successful American-based team in NHL history,
- 8 earning 11 Stanley Cup titles in 1936, 1937, 1943, 1950, 1952,
- 9 1954, 1955, 1997, 1998, 2002, and 2008. They have also recorded
- 10 more than 3,000 wins and made twenty-five consecutive playoff
- 11 appearances, a record that underscores their lasting excellence;

- 13 Whereas, The enduring success of the Detroit Red Wings has
- 14 been built by generations of legendary owners, coaches, players,
- 15 and staff. Since 1926, more than 1,000 players have donned the
- 16 winged wheel and the franchise remains one of the most honored
- 17 organizations in the Hockey Hall of Fame with eighty-three iconic
- 18 inductees; and
- 19 Whereas, Though the Red Wings are known for their accolades
- 20 and on the ice accomplishments, their influence has extended far
- 21 beyond the rink. The team has become a cultural institution,
- 22 inspiring generations of devoted fans and drawing recognition from
- 23 across the sports and entertainment world. From celebrities proudly
- 24 wearing the winged wheel to appearances in film and media, the Red
- 25 Wings have helped shape Michigan's identity as the home of
- 26 Hockeytown and the pinnacle of hockey excellence; and
- 27 Whereas, The Red Wings also reflect the best of Michigan
- 28 through their steadfast commitment to service. Through the Detroit
- 29 Red Wings Foundation, the team has consistently provided support

1 and resources to programs that strengthen local communities and

- 2 foster youth development through hockey across the state; and
- 3 Whereas, As the Red Wings enter their 100th season, it is
- 4 fitting to honor the enduring legacy they have built over the past
- 5 century. Thorough triumphs and challenges, this team has remained a
- 6 source of pride, unity, and identity for generations of
- 7 Michiganders. They have stood not only as a symbol of sporting
- 8 excellence, but also of the spirit and strength within our state;
- 9 now, therefore, be it
- 10 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of
- 11 this legislative body commemorate the Detroit Red Wings on their
- 12 100th season. We honor a century of excellence, resilience, and
- 13 service to the people of Michigan; and be it further
- 14 Resolved, That copies of this resolution be transmitted to the
- 15 Detroit Red Wings organization as a token of our esteem and
- 16 appreciation.
