- 2 Awareness Month in the state of Michigan.
- 3 Whereas, One in twelve children in the United States will
- 4 experience the death of a parent or sibling before graduating from
- 5 high school; and
- 6 Whereas, Every child who has known love is capable of deep
- 7 grief, and every grieving child deserves understanding, support,
- 8 and compassion; and
- 9 Whereas, Children who experience the death of a loved one
- 10 often feel isolated, different from their peers, and may struggle
- 11 to express or process complex emotions; and
- 12 Whereas, Without proper support, childhood grief can have

1 long-term effects on emotional well-being, academic success, and

- 3 Whereas, Michigan is home to compassionate organizations,
- 4 professionals, and volunteers who provide critical grief support to
- 5 children and families-offering safe spaces to share, heal, and
- 6 build resilience after loss; and
- 7 Whereas, As the holiday season approaches and feelings of
- 8 grief can become especially intense, it is important to raise
- 9 awareness of the unique needs of grieving children and to recognize
- 10 the individuals and organizations working tirelessly to help them
- 11 heal; now, therefore, be it
- 12 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of
- 13 this legislative body declare November 2025 as Children's Grief
- 14 Awareness Month in the state of Michigan; and be it further
- 15 Resolved, That we encourage all Michiganders to support
- 16 grieving children and their families, and to promote greater
- 17 understanding of childhood bereavement and the importance of
- 18 compassionate care and community support.
