## SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 84

Senators Damoose, Chang and Moss offered the following resolution:

- 1 A resolution to commemorate the 50th anniversary of the
- 2 sinking of the S.S. Edmund Fitzgerald.
- Whereas, On November 10, 1975, the Great Lakes freighter S.S.
- 4 Edmund Fitzgerald, one of the largest and most storied vessels ever
- 5 to sail the inland seas, sank during a fierce storm on Lake
- 6 Superior, taking with it all 29 brave souls aboard; and
- 7 Whereas, The loss of the Edmund Fitzgerald remains the
- 8 deadliest tragedy in Great Lakes shipping history, a solemn
- 9 reminder of both the power of nature and the courage of those who
- 10 dedicate their lives to maritime commerce; and
- 11 Whereas, The men who perished that night were fathers, sons,
- 12 brothers, and friends hardworking crewmen who embodied the grit,
- 13 perseverance, and devotion that define Michigan's maritime

- 1 heritage; and
- 2 Whereas, The 29 men lost on the Edmund Fitzgerald join more
- 3 than 30,000 mariners who are estimated to have perished throughout
- 4 history on the Great Lakes; and
- 5 Whereas, The sinking of the Edmund Fitzgerald spurred
- 6 improvements in maritime safety, leading to stronger regulations,
- 7 enhanced ship design, and advanced weather monitoring, ensuring
- 8 that the sacrifice of her crew contributed to greater protections
- 9 for future generations; and
- 10 Whereas, For five decades, the memory of the Edmund Fitzgerald
- 11 has been honored in Michigan and across the Great Lakes through
- 12 solemn ceremonies, tolling church bells, and story telling that
- 13 keeps a living legacy of those lost; and
- 14 Whereas, The people of Michigan remain forever bound to the
- 15 waters of the Great Lakes, which have shaped our history, culture,
- 16 and economy, and on this solemn anniversary we reaffirm our
- 17 enduring respect for those who work and sacrifice upon them; now,
- 18 therefore, be it
- 19 Resolved by the Senate, That the members of this legislative
- 20 body commemorate the 50th anniversary of the sinking of the S.S.
- 21 Edmund Fitzgerald and pay tribute to the memory of her 29 crew
- 22 members, whose lives were tragically lost on November 10, 1975; and
- 23 be it further
- Resolved, That November 10, 2025 will be recognized as "Edmund
- 25 Fitzgerald Day" in honor of the mariners lost in that tragic event;
- 26 and be it further
- 27 Resolved, That copies of this resolution be transmitted to the
- 28 families of the crew, maritime organizations, and museums dedicated
- 29 to preserving the history of the Great Lakes as a lasting testament

1 to Michigan's reverence for the Edmund Fitzgerald and her crew.
