## SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 82

Senator Brinks offered the following resolution: 1 A resolution to condemn political violence in all forms, regardless of political party or ideology, and affirm the 2 3 commitment of the Michigan Senate to peaceful dispute resolution through lawful, democratic means. 4 5 Whereas, Robust debate, freedom of expression, civic participation, fair elections, and the peaceful exchange of ideas 6 are the basis for democracy, all of which become endangered when 7 violence is used as a political weapon; and 8 9 Whereas, Political violence includes a wide range of actions, 10 from symbolic intimidation to lethal attacks, and seeks to undermine public institutions, reduce trust, and suppress political 11 12 participation; and 13 Whereas, According to research from the University of Maryland, there were approximately 150 politically motivated 14

1 attacks in the United States during the first six months of 2025,

- 2 nearly doubling the number of attacks seen over the same period in
- **3** 2024; and
- 4 Whereas, Political violence impacts individuals across the
- 5 political spectrum at the federal, state, and local level, as well
- 6 as journalists, activists, and public figures; and
- 7 Whereas, Proponents of political violence seek to suppress
- 8 free speech and debate by creating a climate of fear and
- 9 intimidation in hopes of stifling civic participation from
- 10 constituents, public figures, and activists; and
- 11 Whereas, The Michigan Senate values the right of Michiganders
- 12 to freely express themselves and feel safe when doing so, as civic
- 13 engagement is crucial for a successful democracy; and
- 14 Whereas, We urge law enforcement authorities at all levels to
- 15 thoroughly investigate, prosecute, and hold accountable those who
- 16 commit to incite political violence; and
- 17 Whereas, The Michigan Senate commends law enforcement and all
- 18 public officials who work to respond to such violence; and
- 19 Whereas, We condemn actions and rhetoric that is intended to
- 20 harass, intimidate, silence, and dehumanize public officials,
- 21 political candidates, public figures, and their respective family
- 22 members and staff; now, therefore, be it
- 23 Resolved by the Senate, That the members of this legislative
- 24 body condemn political violence in all forms, regardless of
- 25 political party or ideology, and affirm the commitment of the
- 26 Michigan Senate to peaceful dispute resolution through lawful,
- 27 democratic means.
