

DEPUTIES AND EMPLOYEES (EXCERPT)
Act 123 of 1933

45.51 Deputies and employees of county officers in counties over 500,000; appointment, compensation.

Sec. 1.

In counties having a population of more than 500,000 the county treasurer, the register of deeds, the coroners and the drain commissioner shall and are hereby authorized to appoint a chief deputy, and all other deputies, clerks and employees employed in the departments of each of the said officers. The number and salaries of the said deputies, clerks and employees herein provided for shall be fixed in the same manner as they are fixed for deputies, clerks and employees of the other departments of the county government. The salaries of such deputies, clerks and employees shall be payable in the same manner and at the same time that other county employees are paid.
