18.1364a Legislatively directed spending items; disclosure form.

Sec. 364a.

(1) The public disclosure form for a legislatively directed spending item required under section 364 must be submitted in the following form to be considered:

- (2) As used in this section:

- (a) "Immediate family member" means any of the following individuals:
 - (i) An individual's parent, child, sibling, or spouse.
 - (ii) Any other individual who resides in the same household as the individual.
- (b) "Legislatively directed spending item" means that term as defined in section 364.
- (c) "Legislator" means a duly elected individual who serves in either the senate or house of representatives.
- (d) "Nonprofit corporation" means that term as defined in section 108 of the nonprofit corporation act, 1982 PA 162, MCL 450.2108.
- (e) "Staff member" means an individual who is currently or, within the prior 2 years, has been employed by the senate or house of representatives.
