Representatives,

I have signed Enrolled House Bill 4236, which makes appropriations to aid in the support of the public universities of the state, and for certain other purposes relating to education, for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020. I have, however, disapproved two items pursuant to article 5, section 19 of the Michigan Constitution of 1963. The specific item vetoes are detailed in the attached copy of the bill that has been filed with the secretary of state.

To provide direction regarding the implementation of this appropriations act, I note the following:

- Section 289 is unenforceable to the extent that it assigns the auditor general powers and duties other than those specified in article 4, section 53 of the Michigan Constitution of 1963.
- Those provisions of this bill that express merely the intent, advice, preferences, or wishes of the legislature do not impose conditions upon appropriations and are non-binding.
